mary walcott elizabeth hubbert ann putnam  
mary warrin an abijoll williams when mary  
dally came to the table was choaked in such  
a most grievous manner that the honorable  
magistrall could not proceed to her examination  
untill they desired new helpe to be procured  
and in private time in sum time after all they  
remained in this sad condition of being all most  
choaked to death and when they were a bit again  
to speak they all with one consent charged her  
that she did them that mischief / all so heard her  
sum of them complain nowy often of her hurting  
them with the spindall as a wheel.
