The deposition of Elizabeth Hubbard aged about 17 years who testifieth and saith that about the 15th march ¹⁶⁹² I saw the apperition of Martha Cory who did immediately hurt me and urged me to write in her book and so she continued hurting of me by times till the 25 march being the day of her examination: and then in the time of her examination she did torment me most dreadfully by biting pinching and almost chocking me the marks of which I showed to several and at the same time also I saw the apperition of Martha Cory grievously afflict Mercy Lewis: and also several times since the apperition of Martha Cory has most grievously afflicted me and urged me vehemently to write in her book also on the day of her examination I saw Martha Cory or her Apperance most grievously torment many walcott Mercy Lewis Abigail Williams and Rose Putnam and I believe in my heart that Martha Cory is a dreadfull witch and that she hath very often affected and tormented me and the aforesaid persons by act of wickedcraft here in Fair.
