Sorceries Wickedly Maliciously and feloniously both
used practisid and exercised At and in the Towne
of Salem in the County of Essex - aforesaid
in upon and against one Eliza Booth of Salem
- - - - - aforesaid Single Woman -

Eliza Booth - by which said wicked acts y^e said
~~Eliza Booth~~ the day & Yeare - aforesaid and diverse
other days and times both before and after was and
is Tortured Afflicted Consumed Pined Wasted and
Sorrowed and also for sundry other acts of witchcraft
by the said Willmott Rodd Comitted and done before
and since that time against our Sou^{erain} Lord & Lady
the King & Queen thaire Crowne and Dignity
and the forme of the Statute in that case made
and Provided.
