oppressing of Dunwry about Salom as they relate, having  
Received particuler Order from the Govern<sup>rs</sup> Council of  
their Maj<sup>ties</sup> Colony of the Massachusetts, for the same, you  
may not fail to take in, Dated in portsmouth in the  
province of New-hampshire, April. 30<sup>th</sup>. 1692.
