Hubbard of Salem aforesaid single woman: by wh<sup>t</sup>  
said wicked Arts the said Elizabeth Hubbard, the  
said first Day of March in the fourth year  
aforesaid: and at divers other Days and times  
as well before as after, was and is Tortured  
afflicted. binded wasted and tormentid. as also for  
sundry other act of Witchcraft by s<sup>t</sup> Sarah  
Good Committed and done before and since  
that time agt the Pace of our Sovereign Lord  
and Lady King & Queen of England, and agt  
the forme of the Statute in that Case made &  
Proceded.
