and Lady William & Mary by the Grace of God of
England Scotland France and Ireland Defender of
the faith &c. and divers other Days, and times, as
well before as after certain detestable artes
called witchcraft, & sorceries: wickedly and felon-
-iously hath bin practis'd & exercised: at and
within the Towne Ship of Salem in the County
of Essex aforesaid. in upon and against Elizabeth
Hubbard: of Salem aforesaid single woman: by which
said wicked arts the said Elizabeth Hubbard, the
said first Day of March in the fourth year
aforesaid: and at divers other Days and times
as well before as after, was and is tortur'd
afflict'd: Invid. waked and tormented. as also for
undry other acts of witchcraft by s^r. Sarah
Good committed and done before and since
that time against the Peace of our Sovereign Lord
and Lady King & Queen of England, and against
the forme of the Statute in that behalf made &
provid'd.
